ANNUAL REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Section 353 F-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes

This annual report has been prepared in compliance with Section 353 F-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. This Act states, "...The commission shall submit to the legislature, not fewer than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session, an annual report of its activities and of its recommended legislative proposals.

From July 1, 2012 to June 21, 2013, the Corrections Population Management Commission (CPMC) consisted of eleven members: State Attorney General, Director of Public Safety, Prosecuting Attorney, Public Defender, Chairperson of the Hawaii Paroling Authority, Senator, Representative, Judge, Adult Probation Administrator, a member from the private sector, and a rehabilitated offender.

On June 21, 2013, the 2013 Legislature, passed Act 154, and added the OHA administrator and a member of the public, who is knowledgeable about issues relating to the criminal justice system and has substantial experience or expertise in traditional Native Hawaiian practices, as additional CPMC members. Act 154 was made effective upon approval.

From July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013, the CPMC met once on January 9, 2013. CPMC meeting minutes for this meeting have not been approved by the CPMC members.

There are no recommended legislative proposals by the CPMC to report.
