Kauai Extended Furlough Inmate Reported Missing from Transitional Home

HONOLULU – Extended furlough inmate Orlando Manguchei was reported missing at 8:15 last night by staff at the transitional home he was residing in. The home is located in Kapaa. Kauai Police were notified.

Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the correctional facility.

Orlando was serving time for Terroristic Threatening, Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3, and a Parole Violation. His sentence end date was August of this year.

Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges once he is found.

Orlando is 43 years old. He is 5'6" and weighs 150 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
