MISSING LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE CONFIRMED IN HONOLULU POLICE CUSTODY

HONOLULU – Laumaka Work Furlough Center inmate Michael Salas is confirmed to be in Honolulu Police custody. They notified Public Safety officials that they arrested him at about 8:20 p.m. yesterday in Nanakuli.

On Sunday, Laumaka Work Furlough Center inmates Michael Salas and George Goings were reported missing from a headcount at about 1:45 a.m.

Salas was serving time for Robbery 2. His parole consideration hearing is scheduled for September.

Goings is still missing. He was serving time for various drug charges and ownership/possession of a prohibited firearm. His next parole consideration hearing is September of this year.

Goings is 43-years old. He is 5'9", weighs 207 lbs., and has brown hair and brown eyes.

Goings and Salas were both community custody inmates in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
