## OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM FURLOUGH DAY PASS

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center furlough inmate Brandon Medeiros failed to return from a day pass this afternoon. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Medeiros left OCCC at 8:30 a.m. and failed to return at the scheduled time of 1:30 p.m.

Medeiros is 27 years old. He is 5'6" and weighs 154 lbs. He has black hair and brown eyes. He has a tattoo under his left eye and on the right side of his neck.

He is serving time for Assault 2, Robbery 2, and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle. His next parole hearing is scheduled for March of this year.

Medeiros is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges.

Community custody is the lowest classification status.
