MISSING OCCC INMATE VOLUNTARILY TURNS HIMSELF IN TO OCCC

HONOLULU – A missing work furlough inmate is back in custody after voluntarily turning himself in to OCCC at 3 p.m.

Oahu Community Correctional Center furlough inmate Isaiah Kaisa failed to return from work yesterday morning. He was scheduled to return at 3:30 a.m.

He is serving time for Forgery 2, I.D. Theft 3, Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle, Ownership or Possession of a Prohibited Weapon. An escape charge is expected to be added. His next parole hearing is scheduled for June of this year.

Kaisa is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program. Inmates in the work furlough program are either actively seeking employment or working in the community. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
