OCCC INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM WORK FURLOUGH

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) furlough inmate Isaiah Kaisa failed to return from work this morning. He was scheduled to return at 3:30 a.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Kaisa is 27 years old. He is 6'3" and weighs 259 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.

He is serving time for Forgery 2, I.D. Theft 3, Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle, Ownership or Possession of a Prohibited Weapon. His next parole hearing is scheduled for June of this year.

Kaisa is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program. Inmates in the work furlough program are either actively seeking employment or working in the community. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
