TWO MISSING FURLOUGH INMATES RETURN TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Furlough inmates Brandon Medeiros and Andrew Kaoihana were brought back from Honolulu Circuit Court and processed at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Friday afternoon.

Brandon Medeiros failed to return from a day pass on Tuesday, February 24. He is serving time for Assault 2, Robbery 2, and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle. His next parole hearing is scheduled for March of this year. Medeiros faces an additional escape charge.

Andrew Kaoihana was supposed to be at work on Tuesday, February 24. When he didn't return at the scheduled time of 1 a.m. on Wednesday morning Laumaka Work Furlough Center staff notified Sheriffs and Honolulu Police (HPD). HPD then informed them they had him in custody for a burglary. He is serving time for Burglary 2, Theft 1 and Promoting a Dangerous Drug 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May 2015.
