MISSING OCCC FURLOUGH INMATE VOLUNTARILY TURNS HIMSELF IN TO POLICE

HONOLULU – Missing Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Michael Draper voluntarily turned himself in to Honolulu Police at 12:35 this morning.

Draper left Saturday, April 25 at 7:30 p.m. from Module 20 to go to work. He was supposed to return from work Sunday morning at 8:30 a.m.

Draper is serving time for theft. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May of this year. He faces an additional escape charge.

Draper is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
