OCCC INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM WORK FURLOUGH

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Michael Draper left yesterday (Saturday) at 7:30 p.m. from Module 20 to go to work. He was supposed to return from work this morning at 8:30 a.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Draper is 47-years old. He is 5'7" tall and weighs 153 lbs. He has brown hair and green eyes.

Draper is serving time for theft. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May of this year. He faces an additional escape charge when found.

Draper is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
