LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE CAPTURED

HONOLULU – Honolulu Police notified the Oahu Community Correctional Center of the arrest of work furlough inmate Sean Young. They arrested him at 4 p.m. Young will be returned to the Oahu Community Correctional Center.

On May 6, Young returned to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work. While being processed he ran from the furlough center office.

Young is serving time for Theft, Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle and Criminal Property Damage. His next parole hearing is scheduled for October of this year.

Young is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.

The Laumaka Work Furlough Center is an apartment-like complex off Laumaka Street, one block away from the Oahu Community Correctional Center. Inmates assigned to Laumaka are either actively seeking employment or working in the community.
