MISSING WCCC INMATE CAPTURED BY STATE SHERIFFS

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Cheryl Nihoa was found by Deputy Sheriffs today in the Makiki area at approximately 11:30 a.m.

Nihoa failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass on April 7. She was scheduled to return at 6:15 p.m.

Nihoa was serving time for assault and drug-related charges. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for September of this year.
