MISSING WCCC INMATE CONFIRMED IN HONOLULU POLICE CUSTODY

HONOLULU –Honolulu Police have confirmed the capture of missing Women's Community Correctional Center inmate Jorelyn Pacariem. They notified Public Safety officials that they arrested her around 11:45 a.m. in Mililani.

Pacariem failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass on March 19. She left in the morning and was scheduled to return by 2:30 p.m.

Pacariem was serving time for drug-related charges as well as forgery and I.D. theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added as a new charge. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for July of this year.

Pacariem is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
