WOMEN'S COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM FURLOUGH PASS

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center inmate Grace Tagaolo failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass yesterday (January 30). She was scheduled to return at 9 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Tagaolo was serving time for Ownership of a Prohibited Firearm, Reckless Endangering, Terroristic Threatening and Assault. Escape 2 is expected to be added as a new charge. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for February.

Tagaolo is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. She is 29 years old. She is 5'6", weighs 191 lbs and has brown hair and brown eyes.
