MISSING WOMEN'S PRISON INMATE ARRESTED BY SHERIFFS, RETURNED TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Missing Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Suncirae Silva was arrested by State Sheriffs on Friday and has been returned to the Women's facility.

On April 26, Silva failed to return to WCCC from her furlough day pass.

Silva was serving time for Theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for May of this year. Silva is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
