WCCC INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY FROM FURLOUGH DAY PASS

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Suncirae Silva failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass last night. She was scheduled to return at 9 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Silva was serving time for Theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for May of this year. Silva is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.

Silva is 33-years old. She is 5'3" tall, weighs 296 lbs. and has brown hair and brown eyes.
