### **MISSING LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE DANIEL SEYLER CAPTURED**

HONOLULU – Honolulu Police have confirmed the capture of Oahu Community Correctional Center work furlough inmate Daniel Seyler. They notified Public Safety officials that they arrested him just after 5 p.m. in the Pearl City area.

Seyler left yesterday at 5:15 a.m. from the Laumaka Work Furlough Center to go to work. He was supposed to return from work at 10:30 p.m.

Seyler is currently serving time for assault 2 and failure to comply with sex offender registration requirements. (Reason for the “failure to comply” charge – He was required to update his registration to reflect the assault 2 charge. He updated the registry and was in compliance before being allowed to participate in the furlough program). His next parole hearing is scheduled for September of this year. He faces an additional escape charge when found.

Seyler is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
