OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY AFTER WORK

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Sean Johnson left yesterday (Monday) at 1:30 p.m. from Module 20 to go to work. He was supposed to return from work this morning at 2 a.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Johnson is 43-years old. He is 5'11" tall and weighs 210 lbs. He has gray hair and is balding on top. He has brown eyes and may also have a goatee.

Johnson is serving time for Theft 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for July of this year. He faces an additional escape charge when found.

Johnson is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
