REMAINING TWO MISSING OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATES ARRESTED

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough inmate Ikaika Nixon was returned to OCCC this afternoon by Honolulu Police. He was arrested yesterday at about 4:30 p.m. He faces an additional escape charge.

On Wednesday, April 8, Nixon left at 12:20 p.m. on a job-seeking pass and failed to return to Module 20 at the scheduled time of 5pm. Nixon is serving time for Robbery 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for June of this year.

Missing work furlough Inmate Sean Johnson was also arrested yesterday around 6:15 p.m. by Honolulu Police and is currently still in police custody. He also faces an additional escape charge.

Sean Johnson left Monday, April 13 at 1:30 p.m. from Module 20 to go to work. He was supposed to return from work at 2 a.m. Tuesday. Johnson is serving time for Theft 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for July of this year.
