MISSING BIG ISLAND EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED AND RETURNED TO HAWAII COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER

HONOLULU – Missing extended furlough inmate Joshua Lopes-Keli was returned to the Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) this afternoon by Hawaii Police. Lopes-Keli failed to report to Hale Nani for his scheduled check-in on September 25.

Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the facility but must check in at various times throughout the month.

Lopes-Keli is serving time for Second Degree Robbery. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for October.

26-year old Lopes-Keli is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
