# MISSING EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED

HONOLULU – Missing extended furlough inmate Regina Toro was arrested by Honolulu Police over the weekend. She will be returned to the Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) this evening.

Toro failed to return after work on last Tuesday night to the furlough home where she lives. She was scheduled to return at 11 p.m.

Extended furlough inmates live and work outside of the facility.

Toro was serving time for Forgery and Identity Theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for November 20.

45-year old Toro is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
