EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM WORK FURLOUGH PASS

HONOLULU – Extended furlough inmate Regina Toro failed to return after work last night to the furlough home where she lives. She was scheduled to return at 11 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified. Once found she will be returned to the Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC).

Extended furlough inmates live and work outside of the facility.

Toro was serving time for Forgery and Identity Theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for November 20.

45-year old Toro is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. She is 4'11", weighs 110 lbs. and has brown hair and brown eyes. She has tattoos on her neck that can be seen in the picture provided.
