OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY AFTER WORK

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Rene Adriatico failed to return to OCCC Module 20 after work. He left this morning and was scheduled to return by 4:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

49-year old Adriatico was serving time for drug charges including prohibited acts related to drug paraphernalia and promoting a dangerous drug. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges.

Adriatico is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'4" and weighs 180 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
