HAWAII WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO HALE NANI REINTEGRATION CENTER

HILO – Hale Nani work furlough inmate Jensen Yadao failed to return after work to the reintegration center. Yadao left for work Monday morning and was scheduled to return by 9:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Hawaii County Police were notified.

24-year old Yadao is 5'4" tall and weighs 120 pounds. He has brown hair and brown eyes. He was serving time for assault and abuse of family/household member. He faces an additional escape charge when found. His next parole hearing is scheduled for March 2016.

Yadao is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.

Hale Nani, HCCC's reintegration program, is a dorm-style building located in Panaewa. Hale Nani offers offenders reintegration services and a work release program for sentenced inmates who will be released on the island of Hawaii.
