MISSING EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE TURNS HIMSELF IN AT THE KAUAI COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER

LIHUE – Extended furlough inmate Gilberto Dejos turned himself in at the Kauai Community Correctional Center this evening. Dejos returned to the Kauai Community Correctional Center (KCCC) for his scheduled check-in on Saturday but ran from the parking lot right before being processed.

Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the facility but must check in at various times throughout the month.

Dejos is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is serving time for Promotion of a Detrimental Drug 3. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May 2016. He faces an additional escape charge.
