## KAUAI EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO CHECK IN

KAUAI – Kauai Community Correctional Center (KCCC) extended furlough inmate Aaron Fowler failed to report for his scheduled check-in at a transitional home in Kapaa, Kauai yesterday. State Sheriffs and Kauai Police were notified.

Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the facility but must check in at various times throughout the month.

48-year old Fowler is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'11", weighs 180 lbs. He has green eyes and short, brown hair.

Fowler is serving time for Burglary 2 and Theft of a Credit Card. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for March 2016.
