### MISSING LAUMAKA FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED AND RETURNED TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough program inmates Jerone Batalona was arrested by Honolulu Police and returned to the Oahu Community Correctional Center this afternoon. Batalona failed to return from a furlough pass to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center on September 15. Batalona left in the morning on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5 p.m.

Batalona was serving time for Robbery 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for March 2016.

Batalona is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
