#### WCCC FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO WOMEN'S PRISON AFTER WORK

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) work furlough inmate Crystal Paulino failed to return to the facility after work. She was scheduled to return to WCCC at 2:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

26-year old Paulino was serving time for Forgery and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing is scheduled for December 2015.

Paulino is classified as a community custody inmate which is the lowest custody level. She is 5'6", weighs 120 lbs, and has brown hair and hazel eyes.
