MISSING LAUMAKA FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED AND RETURNED TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough program inmate Vincent Sullivan was arrested by Honolulu Police and returned yesterday afternoon to the Oahu Community Correctional Center. Sullivan failed to return from a furlough pass to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center on August 25. He left in the morning on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5 p.m.

Sullivan was serving time for Robbery 2, Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle and Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His parole hearing was scheduled for this month.

Sullivan is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
