MISSING LAUMAKA INMATE TURNS HIMSELF IN AT THE WORK FURLOUGH CENTER

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough program inmate David Holt is back in OCCC custody after voluntarily turning himself in at the Laumaka Work Furlough Center just before noon today.

Holt failed to return from a furlough pass to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center Monday evening. He left that morning on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5 p.m.

Holt was serving time for Promotion of a Dangerous Drug 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for September.
