MISSING OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE TURNS HIMSELF IN AT FACILITY

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough program inmate Lewellyn Foster is back in custody at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC). Foster returned on his own at approximately 1:40 p.m. Foster failed to return from a furlough day pass to OCCC Module 20 Sunday evening. He left in the morning was scheduled to return by 4 p.m.

Foster was serving time for second degree theft and burglary. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for December.

31-year old Foster is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
