MISSING LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE VOLUNTARILY TURNS HIMSELF IN TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Noah Borgman voluntarily turned himself in to OCCC. He failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work this morning. Borgman left Monday evening and was scheduled to return by 1:30 a.m.

Borgman was serving time for promoting a dangerous drug 3, prohibited acts related to drug paraphernalia and unauthorized entry into a dwelling. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for October.

Borgman is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
