OCCC FURLOUGH PROGRAM INMATE FAILS TO RETURN AFTER JOB-SEEKING

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmates Frederick Asentista failed to return from a furlough pass to the Oahu Community Correctional Center Module 20 this evening. Asentista left this afternoon on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Asentista was serving time for Promotion of a Detrimental Drug 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for February 2016.

Asentista is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 58-years old. He is 5'5" and weighs 159 lbs. He has brown eyes and is balding.
