OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY AFTER WORK

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Barry Williams failed to return to OCCC Module 20 after work. He left this morning and was scheduled to return by 6:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Williams was serving time for promotion of a detrimental drug. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for August.

Balanza is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 33-years old. He is 6'1" and weighs 272 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
