OCCC FURLOUGH PROGRAM INMATE FAILS TO RETURN AFTER JOB-SEEKING

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmates Dorian Guerpo failed to return from a furlough pass to the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Module 20 this evening. Guerpo left this morning on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Guerpo was serving time for Robbery 1. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for March 2016.

38-year old Guerpo is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'9" and weighs 215 lbs. He has brown hair and eyes and a tattoo on his neck which can be seen in the picture provided.
