LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM JOB-SEEKING PASS

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmate John Dziejak failed to return from a furlough pass to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center Wednesday evening. Dziejak left yesterday morning on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Dziejak was serving time for second degree theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for February 2016.

Dziejak is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 45-years old. He is 6'1" and weighs 184 lbs. He has brown hair and hazel eyes.
