OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmate Lewellyn Foster failed to return from a furlough day pass to OCCC Module 20 Sunday evening. Foster left yesterday morning was scheduled to return by 4 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Foster was serving time for second degree theft and burglary. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for December.

31-year old Foster is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'8" and weighs 175 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
