LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM WORK PASS

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Noah Borgman failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work this morning. Borgman left Monday evening and was scheduled to return by 1:30 a.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Borgman was serving time for promoting a dangerous drug 3, prohibited acts related to drug paraphernalia and unauthorized entry into a dwelling. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for October.

Borgman is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 38-years old. He is 5'6" and weighs 210 lbs. He is bald and has brown eyes. He may also have a goatee.
