LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM DAY PASS

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Robert Balanza failed to return from a furlough day pass to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center. Balanza left this morning and was scheduled to return by 4 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Balanza was serving time for various drug charges. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for November.

Balanza is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 50-years old. He is 5'6" and weighs 135 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
