INFORMATIONAL BRIEFING SCHEDULED - PROGRESS REPORT ON PROPOSED REPLACEMENT OF OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER

HONOLULU – Members of the House of Representatives Committee on Public Safety and the Senate Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and Military Affairs will hold an informational briefing to discuss progress on the replacement of the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC):

Pursuant to Act 124, Section 52, the Hawaii Department of Public Safety (PSD) is required to submit a report to the Legislature on the progress of the design, projected cost, financing, private partnership proposals, and accreditation by the American Correctional Association, of a replacement facility. PSD will submit its Progress Report on the future of OCCC to the Hawaii Legislature on February 1, 2017. The report titled "*Planning for the Future of the Oahu Community Correctional Center*, addresses the key topics associated with the planning for a new OCCC as required by Act 124, Section 52.
