MISSING OCCC FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough program inmate Patrick Woods was arrested by Honolulu Police over the weekend. He was returned to the Oahu Community Correctional Center today.

Woods failed to return from work to Module 20 on the night of November 17.

45-year old Woods is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.

Woods was serving time for Forgery 2, Identity Theft 3, and Unauthorized Possession of Confidential Personal Information. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing is scheduled for March 2017.
