MISSING LAUMAKA FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED AND RETURNED TO THE OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmate Lloyd Schmitt is back in custody at the Oahu Community Correctional Center. Honolulu Police arrested Schmitt Wednesday. He was returned to OCCC today.

Schmitt failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work on the evening of May 27.

Schmitt was serving time for Theft 2, Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle and Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3, Unlawful Use of Drug Paraphernalia and Unauthorized Possession of Confidential Personal Information. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for July 2016.

38-year old Schmitt is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
