OCCC FURLOUGH PROGRAM INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Work furlough program inmate Patrick Woods failed to return to Module 20 last night. Woods left for work in the morning and was scheduled to return by 6 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

45-year old Woods is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'10" and weighs 150 lbs. He has brown hair and eyes.

Woods was serving time for Forgery 2, Identity Theft 3, and Unauthorized Possession of Confidential Personal Information. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing is scheduled for March 2017.
