## OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE ARRESTED FOR FAILING TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Wayne Kanakanui was arrested Monday morning for failing to return to the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Module 20 furlough building Sunday afternoon. He left on a day pass in the morning and was scheduled to return by 2:30 p.m. Once Honolulu Police finish processing him, he will be returned to OCCC.

56-year old Kanakanui is serving time for Promoting a Dangerous Drug 2 and 3, and Drug Paraphernalia. His next parole hearing was scheduled for April 2017.

Kanakanui is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program. Inmates in the work furlough program are either actively seeking employment or working in the community. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
