OCCC EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO CHECK IN AT FACILITY

HONOLULU – Extended furlough inmate John Luna failed to report to Module 20 for his scheduled check-in Wednesday afternoon. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the facility but must check in at various times throughout the month.

Luna is serving time for Burglary 1, Robbery 2, Unauthorized Possession of Confidential Personal Information, Possession of a Detrimental Drug 3, and Prohibited Acts Related to Drug Paraphernalia. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. He was tentatively approved for parole and awaiting the parole board to set the release date.

36-year old Luna is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. He is 5'11" tall and weighs 200 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.
