KAUAI COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER INMATES ESCAPED AS A WALKAWAY FROM THE LIFETIME STAND PROGRAM

LIHUE – Lifetime Stand Inmates Kamoeli'i K. Kolo and Joshua Kaimana Preston left the facility as an unauthorized exit during open recreation.

35-year old Kamoeli'l K. Kolo is 5'6" tall and weighs 165 lbs. He has Black hair and Brown eyes. He is a sentenced misdemeanant with a release date of May 21, 2018.

Inmate Kamoeli'l K. Kolo and Joshua Kaimana Preston are a community custody inmate in a furlough program. Community custody is the lowest classification status. 36-year old Joshua Kaimana Preston is 5'11" tall and weighs 190 lbs. He has black hair and brown eyes. He is a sentenced misdemeanant with a release date of March 25, 2018. Both men face an additional escape charge when found.
