MISSING OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE CAPTURED BY HONOLULU POLICE

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough inmate Travis Massey was captured by Honolulu Police at about 4:20 p.m. He was wearing an electronic monitor. With the help of OCCC staff relaying coordinates, HPD was able to track him in Waikiki and arrest him. Massey failed to return after work to Module 20 at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) at 3 p.m.

He is serving time for Burglary 1 and 2, and Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle. His next parole hearing is scheduled for January 2018.

Massey is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program. Inmates in the work furlough program are either actively seeking employment or working in the community. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
