OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Laumaka work furlough inmate Dennis Sonoda failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center. He was supposed to return by 11 a.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

38-year old Sonoda is 5'6" and weighs 161 lbs. He has a brown hair and brown eyes.

Sonoda is serving time for Assault 2 and Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle. His next parole hearing was scheduled for October. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
