## LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN AFTER WORK TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Laumaka work furlough inmate Joel Iuli failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work. He was supposed to return by 7:30 p.m. State Sheriffs were notified.

46-year old Iuli is 5'11" and weighs 196 lbs. He has a brown hair and brown eyes.

Iuli is serving time for Robbery 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

Iuli is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
