OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Laumaka work furlough inmate Keith DeGuzman failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center. He was supposed to return by noon. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

52-year old DeGuzman is 5'8" and weighs 175 lbs. He has a brown hair and brown eyes.

DeGuzman is serving time for Promotion of a Detrimental Drug 3 and Prohibited Acts Related to Drug Paraphernalia. His next parole hearing was scheduled for August. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
