OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE PAUL A SING FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Paul Ah Sing failed to return to OCCC Module 20 work furlough housing unit tonight. He left for work in the morning and was supposed to return by 8:00 pm. Sheriffs and HPD were notified.

Ah Sing is 55 years old, 5'7" tall, and 175 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.

Ah Sing is serving time for Murder 2nd degree. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
